



Joining Climate Alliance

A template for local resolutions on membership

*The following suggestion for local resolutions can be adapted or added to as needed. Please keep the basic criteria for valid local resolutions in mind: **resolutions must contain a commitment to Climate Alliance goals and principles as well as declare the intent to join the network.***

“The **CITY/MUNICIPALITY OF XXX** hereby decides to join the Climate Alliance city network. In doing so, the **XXX** commits to Climate Alliance's principles and goals for comprehensive and just climate action as described in the Climate Alliance Member Charter, as adopted in September 2021 in Wels, Austria.

The Climate Alliance goals can optionally be described here:

Specifically, this means that the **CITY/MUNICIPALITY OF XXX** commits to:

- The implementation of effective and comprehensive climate action in accordance with Climate Alliance principles – fair, nature-based, local, resource-saving and diverse
- The promotion of climate justice together with indigenous peoples – by supporting their rights, protecting biodiversity and abstaining from the use of unsustainably managed timber
- The reduction of CO₂ emissions by 10 percent every 5 years – equivalent to the halving of per capita emissions by 2030 compared to 1990 levels

The **CITY/MUNICIPALITY OF XXX** additionally strives for:

- A 95 percent reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 compared to 1990 levels, in line with IPCC recommendations”

For over 30 years, Climate Alliance member municipalities have been acting in partnership with indigenous rainforest peoples for the benefit of the global climate.
