The workshop aims to showcase the methodology crafted by the Energy Poverty Advisory Hub (EPAH), designed to assist local governments in addressing energy poverty and in crafting solutions tailored to their communities. Throughout the event, attendees will explore various phases of energy poverty as illustrated by real-world examples shared by academic and local government practitioners. Discussions will delve into the use of indicators during diagnosis and explore potential solutions for planning and implementation, touching upon the specific examples of one-stop shops, energy communities, financing mechanisms and positive energy districts.

Participants will collaboratively develop a plan to address energy poverty using the EPAH methodology framework. This exercise offers a hands-on opportunity to grapple with the challenges, decisions, and practical considerations inherent in developing effective strategies for combating energy poverty.

Organised by the Energy Poverty Advisory Hub in partnership with the Covenant of Mayors and the JUST-PEPP project, the workshop will be followed by opportunities to visit the mobile *Ponto de Transição* one-stop shop that will travel in Cascais for the occasion and join networking drinks with other conference participants hosted by the Covenant of Mayors.
