Global Covenant of Mayors for Climate and Energy: Accelerating Action and Scaling Up Impact

The Global Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy (GCoM) is an international alliance of cities and local governments with a shared vision of an inclusive, just, low-emission and climate resilient future, helping to meet and exceed the Paris Agreement objectives. The GCoM is also an important tool for promoting and implementing the EU's commitments on climate policies and sustainable energy at the local level. The EU is currently working on the European Green Deal, comprising a first European Climate Law to make 2050 climate-neutrality target legally binding. The EU also envisages to raise its ambition for the 2030 emission reduction targets. Local authorities and cities are crucial actors in implementing these commitments. This year, the GCoM Day provides a platform to showcase how cities are moving from ambitious plans to the implementation of concrete and impactful action.

Local governments will share the results and impacts of multi-level and cross-level partnerships and by sharing their achievements trigger discussion and inspire others. The open dialogue will address innovative approaches and partnerships to accelerate the transition to low-carbon and climate resilience and will provide a space to demonstrate quantified progress of GCoM cities globally in the fight against climate change, while also highlighting gaps and areas for new resource mobilization.

The conversation will focus on:

- Moving from planning to implementation, and showcasing the impacts of local climate and energy action across sectors
- Leveraging multi-level governance and partnerships to accelerate action
- Scaling up implementation of ambitious action by securing adequate financing and innovative solutions

Speakers will comprise of local and regional leaders, representatives of governments, the finance community and business. The key messages will be disseminated through various means, in the context of the Local Governments and Municipal Authorities (LGMA) constituency planned activities.
