

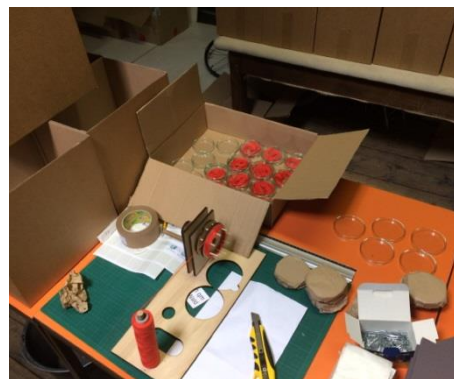


One square meter of forest – education materials for children and youngsters

With the help of a student’s book, accompanying booklet as well as an exploration kit, a workshop of 1-3 days can be carried out.
