Energy Poverty Nexus supports Member States in establishing and strengthening national energy poverty observatories that transform fragmented information into coordinated governance mechanisms. It builds long-term institutional capacity to monitor and address energy poverty systematically.

ESTABLISHING AND STRENGTHENING NATIONAL ENERGY POVERTY OBSERVATORIES

Energy Poverty Nexus supports the establishment of six new national energy poverty observatories in **Bulgaria, Croatia, Estonia, Hungary, Poland** and **Spain**.

The project aims to strengthen the existing observatory in **Greece**, reinforcing its analytical capacity and governance function.

The observatories will operate within the broader European policy landscape, contributing to improved national monitoring, coordination and implementation of energy poverty alleviation strategies and actions.

FROM FRAGMENTED DATA TO STRUCTURED MONITORING SYSTEMS

The observatories will aim to establish structures for:

Consolidating national and regional datasets



Monitoring energy poverty indicators

Supporting policy formulation and evaluation



Enabling cross-sector collaboration

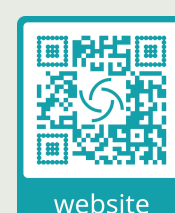
FROM PROJECT OUTPUTS TO INSTITUTIONAL FRAMEWORKS
